

Terms and conditions of registration

By registering to attend 'Te Kura Roa', you agree to the following terms and conditions.

In the terms and conditions that following 'the Organisers' refers to the Organising Committee of '**Te Kura Roa'** (may otherwise be referred to as the Event) and its constituent members, including the Rauika Māngai, acting as Organisers and its agents.

CANCELLATION & REFUND TERMS

Cancellation of registration must be made in writing to the Event Coordinator, Nicky Smith (email: <u>n.smith@gns.cri.nz</u>).

Cancellations received prior to 8 March 2024 will receive a refund less an administration fee of \$10 + GST per registration (\$11.50). **No refunds** will be made if cancellations are received on or after this date.

If you are unable to attend, you can make a substitution. You must advise the Event Coordinator of any substitution (email: <u>n.smith@gns.cri.nz</u>). Reference '**Te Kura Roa'** in all correspondence.

Registrations may not be shared.

COVID-19 – Should the New Zealand government alter requirements to safely host an event the guidelines under which this event is held are subject to change. Anyone attending the in-person event must abide by any changes in the requirements as noted by the New Zealand government to safely host an event.

You will have the choice to wear a face covering on-site during the event, but this is not compulsory.
